ILLEGAL ALIEN SENTENCED

Troy Resident Sentenced for Illegal Re-entry to United States

UNITED STATES ATTORNEY RICHARD S. HARTUNIAN announced that AVIMAEL ROBLERO ROBLERO, age 23, of Troy, New York, was sentenced today by United States District Judge Mae A. D'Agostino, in Albany, New York, for illegally reentering the United States after removal. ROBLERO ROBLERO was sentenced to imprisonment for a term of time served (49 days), followed by one year of supervised release. Judge D'Agostino immediately remanded ROBLERO ROBLERO to the custody of the Department of Homeland Security for removal proceedings.

Today's sentencing followed ROBLERO ROBLERO's June 2, 2011 guilty plea.

ROBLERO ROBLERO, a citizen of Mexico, was involuntarily removed from the United States to Mexico on December 4, 2006 after being encountered by ICE in Troy, New York. On May 12, 2011, ROBLERO ROBLERO was encountered by Watervliet Police during a traffic stop. An Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) officer responded to the vehicle stop and determined ROBLERO ROBLERO to be a previously removed illegal alien.

This matter was investigated by the Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Albany, New York and the Watervliet Police Department.
