## OGK GANG MEMBER SENTENCING

Thirteenth OGK Defendant Sentenced, Receiving 73 Additional Months Incarceration in Federal Racketeering Case

United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian announced today that **DYJUAN TATRO**, a/k/a **Dy**, age 25, of Albany, New York, was sentenced today by United States District Court Judge Gary L. Sharpe to 73 months incarceration (**TATRO** was facing a sentence of 151 months but received 78 months credit for time already served), and 3 years of supervised release following his release from incarceration. This sentence follows his plea of guilty to a racketeering conspiracy charge as set forth in Count 1 of a federal indictment relating to the criminal activities of the **ORIGINAL GANGSTER KILLERS (OGK) or "Downtown"** gang, which operated within the City of Albany.

**DYJUAN TATRO** is the thirteenth OGK gang member to be sentenced. **TATRO** previously had admitted that he was an **OGK** gang member and had conspired with other persons to possess with intent to distribute and distribute crack cocaine within the Northern District of New York. **TATRO'S** involvement in the narcotics conspiracy involved the possession with intent to distribute and distribution of more than 50 grams of cocaine base (crack cocaine). **TATRO** had also previously admitted that he had participated in acts of violence against rival gang members.

This prosecution resulted from a joint investigation conducted by the Office of the United States Attorney for the Northern District of New York; the Federal Bureau of Investigation,
