DRUG CONSPIRATOR SENTENCED

Defendant Who Packaged and Loaded Marijuana in Cross-Country Marijuana Distribution Conspiracy Sentenced to Time Served

Albany, New York —United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian and John P. Gilbride, Special Agent in Charge of the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), New York Field Division, announced that ROBERT REINFURT, age 31, of Cottonwood Heights, Utah, was sentenced today by the Honorable Gary L. Sharpe in Federal District Court in Albany on his guilty plea to one count of conspiring to possess and distribute marijuana. REINFURT was sentenced to time served, four years of supervised release and 200 hours of community service.

REINFURT pled guilty on April 27, 2011 and admitted that in 2009 he joined a conspiracy that involved the distribution of marijuana from California to various places across the country, including Wilton, New York. REINFRUT helped package and load bags of marijuana into various vehicles and trailers which were used to transport the marijuana for further redistribution.

This case was investigated by the Capital District Drug Enforcement Task Force; the New York State Police; the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Central District of Illinois; the Quad City Metropolitan Enforcement Group; the Henry County, Illinois State's Attorney's Office; the DEA Rock Island, Illinois Post of Duty; the DEA Norfolk, Virginia Resident Office; and the Illinois State Police.
