## **BROADALBIN RESIDENT CHARGED WITH POSSESSING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY**

### *Defendant Alleged to Have Possessed a Computer Containing Child Pornography*

Albany, New York —United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian and Patrick Coultry, Resident Agent in Charge of the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Department of Homeland Security, announce the filing of a Complaint charging TIMOTHY BREHMER, age 35, of Broadalbin, New York, with possessing child pornography, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(5)(B).<sup>1</sup> Count 1 of the Complaint charges that on or about December 6, 2011, BREHMER knowingly possessed images of child pornography. If found guilty of Count 1, the defendant faces a statutory maximum sentence of ten years of imprisonment and a maximum fine of \$250,000.00.

BREHMER had his initial appearance on the charge in Albany on December 8, 2011 before the Honorable David R. Homer, United States Magistrate Judge. BREHMER was released on conditions pending his preliminary hearing scheduled for December 27, 2011 before Judge Homer..

This case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Department of Homeland Security. This case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Rick Belliss.
