CORINTH, NY MAN SENTENCED FOR BEING A FELON IN POSSESSION OF FIREARMS

Defendant Was Found Guilty by Jury in June Sentenced to 33 Months Imprisonment

Albany, New York —United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian announced that VON SCOTT LINDAHL, age 42, of Corinth, New York, was sentenced by the Honorable Gary L. Sharpe in Federal District Court in Albany following his trial and conviction on one count of possession of firearms by a prohibited person. LINDAHL was sentenced to 33 months of imprisonment to be followed by three years of supervised release.

On November 17, 2010, acting on a tip, members of the Warren County Sheriff's Office executed a search warrant at Lindahl's home located on Ridge Road in Queensbury, NY. At that time, investigators found LINDAHL in possession of three firearms: a cocked and loaded .357 caliber rifle, a loaded .410 caliber shotgun, and a .22 caliber rifle. These firearms were forfeited as part of his sentence.

LINDAHL was found guilty of being a felon (prohibited person) in possession of firearms following a jury verdict on June 1, 2011.

This case was investigated by the Warren County Sheriff's Office, the Warren County District Attorney's Office, and the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives.
