SARATOGA SPRINGS MAN WHO FAILED TO UPDATE SEX OFFENDER INFORMATION SENTENCED

Sentenced to 27 Months of Imprisonment for Traveling from New York to Maryland without Updating his Sex Offender Registration Information

Albany, New York —United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian and David McNulty, U.S. Marshal for the Northern District of New York, announced that THOMAS ALLEN, age 25, of Hagerstown, Maryland, was sentenced on May 11, 2012 by United States District Court Judge Mae A. D'Agostino, in Federal District Court in Albany, on his guilty plea to one count of failing to update his New York State sex offender registration information in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2250(a). ALLEN was sentenced to 27 months of imprisonment to be followed by a term of supervised release for life.

On January 12, 2012, ALLEN pled guilty and admitted that, in 2010, he was convicted of a sex offense in the State of New York. ALLEN also admitted that, in November 2010, he moved from Saratoga Springs to Hagerstown, Maryland. ALLEN further admitted that he resided in Hagerstown, Maryland until the time of his arrest on June 11, 2011. Records from the sex offender registries in New York and Maryland established that ALLEN did not update his change of address information in New York and did not register as a sex offender in Maryland.

This case was investigated by the U.S. Marshals Service and the Washington County, Maryland, Sheriff's Office.
