DEFENDANT WHO RECEIVED CHILD PORNOGRAPHY PLEADS GUILTY

Broadalbin Man Pleads Guilty to Receiving Multiple Still Images and Videos of Child Pornography

Albany, New York —United States Attorney Richard S. Hartunian and Patrick Coultry, Resident Agent in Charge of the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Department of Homeland Security (HSI), announced that TIMOTHY BREHMER, age 35, of Broadalbin, New York, pled guilty today in United States District Court in Albany before Chief United States District Court Judge Gary L. Sharpe to one count of receiving child pornography.

Pursuant to a written plea agreement, BREHMER admitted that between April 2007 and December 5, 2011, he used the Internet to access various child pornography websites. While accessing some of the child pornography websites, BREHMER downloaded multiple still images and videos of child pornography onto his home computer. BREHMER also agreed, as part of his plea agreement, that within thirty days he will surrender his New York State teaching certificate and tender his resignation of employment with the Ballston Spa Central School District.

Sentencing was scheduled by Chief Judge Sharpe for September 12, 2012, at 2:00 p.m. in U.S. District Court in Albany, New York. BREHMER faces a mandatory minimum sentence of at least five years imprisonment, up to a maximum of twenty years imprisonment. BREHMER was released pending his sentencing.

This case was investigated by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Department of Homeland Security.
