**FORMER SCARSDALE HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER PLEADS GUILTY
TO POSSESSION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY**

MICHAEL J. GARCIA, the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, announced that ALLEN JULIER, a former teacher at Scarsdale High School, pleaded guilty today to possession of child pornography. The plea was entered before United States District Court Judge KENNETH M. KARAS in White Plains federal court. JULIER was remanded pending his sentencing, which is scheduled for May 2, 2008.

JULIER faces a maximum sentence of 10 years' imprisonment.

According to the one-count felony Information to which JULIER pleaded, on or about September 4, 2007, JULIER possessed more than 100 images and more than 10 video files containing child pornography on his home computer in Carmel, New York.

Mr. GARCIA praised the efforts of Immigration and Customs Enforcement, the New York State Police, and the Carmel Police Department in connection with this investigation.

Assistant United States Attorney ANNA M. SKOTKO is in charge of the prosecution.
