STATEMENT ON THE CONVICTION OF DARRYL HENDERSON

"At the conclusion of a two-month jury trial and after two days of jury deliberation, Darryl Henderson was found guilty of racketeering, racketeering conspiracy, narcotics conspiracy counts, and robbery. As part of its racketeering verdicts, the jury specifically found Henderson guilty of participating in three acts of felony murder. Henderson was acquitted of three substantive murder counts. We respect the decision of the jury and are pleased that Henderson faces a mandatory minimum sentence of 20 years' imprisonment and a maximum sentence of life for committing these very serious crimes," stated MICHAEL J.
