**FEDERAL GRAND JURY IN WHITE PLAINS INDICTS THREE  
IN YONKERS ROBBERY AND MURDER**

LEV L. DASSIN, the Acting United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, and JOSEPH M. DEMAREST JR., the Assistant Director in Charge of the New York Field Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI"), announced today the unsealing of an Indictment charging DAVON YOUNG, a/k/a "Burners," THOMAS CHAMBLISS, a/k/a "TC," and GREGORY FULLER, a/k/a "Murder," for their alleged roles in the robbery and murder of TYRONE BERGMAN in Yonkers, New York, on or about January 14, 2008.

All three defendants are charged in Count One of the Indictment with conspiring to commit and committing, within federal interstate commerce jurisdiction, a gunpoint robbery of cocaine; and in Count Two with using a firearm during the cocaine robbery to kill BERGMAN. The robbery and killing are alleged to have taken place on or about January 14, 2008, in the vicinity of 177 Helena Avenue, Yonkers, New York.

YOUNG, CHAMBLISS, and FULLER appeared in White Plains federal court today for their initial appearances before United States Magistrate Judge GEORGE A. YANTHIS, and their case was assigned to United States District Judge CATHY SEIBEL.

Mr. DASSIN praised the investigative work of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Yonkers Police Department.

If convicted, the defendants face maximum sentences of death or life in prison on Count Two and 20 years' imprisonment on Count One.

Assistant United States Attorney NICHOLAS McQUAID is in charge of the prosecution.

The charges contained in the Indictment are merely accusations, and the defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
