**NEW ROCHELLE MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO ANABOLIC STEROIDS  
CHARGES AND TO ASSAULTING FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS**

PREET BHARARA, the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, announced that SCOTT SIEGEL pleaded guilty today in White Plains federal court to one count of distributing and possessing with intent to distribute anabolic steroids and two counts of impeding federal officers.

According to publicly filed documents and as stated by the Government during various proceedings in the case, on February 18, 2009, SIEGEL fled in Eastchester, New York, when approached by law enforcement officers. During his flight, SIEGEL used his truck to hit a car occupied by two law enforcement officers and drove his truck directly at another officer in an apparent attempt to run him over. Further, on February 19, 2009, search warrants executed at SIEGEL's residence and another location led to the recovery of approximately 1,500 bottles containing anabolic steroids.

During his plea allocution, SIEGEL admitted possessing steroids with the intent to distribute them. He also admitted that, on the day of his arrest, he used his vehicle to obstruct and impede law enforcement officers.

SIEGEL, 35, of New Rochelle, New York, is scheduled to be sentenced by United States District Judge KENNETH M. KARAS on January 14, 2010. He faces maximum penalties of 45 years in prison and fines of \$750,000, or twice the gross gain or loss resulting from the crime.
