## GREECE MAN SENTENCED IN CHILD PORNOGRAPHY CASE

ROCHESTER, N.Y.-- U.S. Attorney William J. Hochul, Jr. announced today that Robert G. Miller, Jr., 30, of Greece, N.Y., who was convicted of possession of child pornography, was sentenced to 18 months in prison and 15 years supervised release by U.S. District Judge David G. Larimer.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Tiffany H. Lee, who is handling the case, stated that the defendant possessed an HP laptop computer and a Western Digital external hard drive, each containing images of child pornography. Miller used the file-sharing software Limewire and he had images available to share. The images included depictions of prepubescent children. Miller also had 81 videos that depicted images of violence involving children.

This case was brought as part of Project Safe Childhood, a nationwide initiative to combat the growing epidemic of child sexual exploitation and abuse launched in May 2006 by the Department of Justice. Led by United States Attorneys' Offices and the Criminal Division's Child Exploitation and Obscenity Section (CEOS), Project Safe Childhood marshals federal, state and local resources to better locate, apprehend and prosecute individuals who exploit children via the Internet, as well as to identify and rescue victims.
