NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of a one-count indictment¹ charging **ROHAN CHRISTOPHER CREARY**, a Jamaican national also known as “Gary Thomas,” with unlawful re-entry into the United States after deportation, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326. The one-count indictment alleges that on August 2, 2007, CREARY was found in Phoenixville, Pennsylvania after having been previously deported from the United States in 1996.

This indictment arose out of an investigation conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). Defendant CREARY faces a maximum sentence of 20 years imprisonment, five years supervised release, a \$250,000 fine and a \$100 special assessment.
