**NEWS RELEASE**

United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of an Indictment<sup>1</sup> against defendant James Meads, a/k/a “Mark Pril,” “Mark Ball,” “Sebastian Ruetzel,” and “John Vestal,” for possessing a counterfeit security, forging a passport, transferring fraudulent identification, aggravated identity theft, and destruction of physical evidence in a federal investigation.

If convicted, defendant faces a consecutive two-year mandatory minimum term of imprisonment to any sentence imposed.
