INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about October 29, 2007, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of
Pennsylvania, defendant

GLENFORD WILLIAMS,

an alien and a citizen and native of Jamaica, who had previously been deported from the United States on or about July 6, 1984, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully re-entered the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor, the Secretary of the

Department of Homeland Security, to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), (b)(1).
