INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about November 16, 2006, in Boothwyn, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

PARIS LAMONT CARNEY

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Sun East Federal Credit Union lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$6,360.25 belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Sun East Federal Credit Union, the deposits of which were insured by the National Credit Union Administration, and, in so doing, defendant CARNEY knowingly and unlawfully assaulted and put in jeopardy the lives of the employees of Sun East Federal Credit Union, and other persons, by use of a dangerous weapon, that is, a .38-caliber revolver.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(d).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about November 16, 2006, in Boothwyn, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

PARIS LAMONT CARNEY

knowingly used and carried a firearm, that is, a .38-caliber revolver, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, armed bank robbery in violation of Title 18 United States Code, Section 2113.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1).
