United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of an indictment<sup>1</sup> charging TYREE WAY with one count of possessing a firearm after having been convicted of a felony, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of ten years imprisonment and a \$250,000 fine. This case was investigated by the Temple University Police Department, the Philadelphia Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco & Firearms. This case is part of Project Safe Neighborhoods, a federal initiative designed to identify and prosecute firearms offenders in federal court, where the defendant is likely to receive a substantial sentence upon conviction. The case has been assigned to Assistant United States Attorney W. Craig Williams.
