NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of a four-count indictment¹ charging CURTIS BRABHAM with bank robbery on September 7, 12, 21, and 24, 2007. The indictment alleges that the defendant committed a series of bank robberies in which he twice robbed the Sovereign Bank branches located at 1 Belmont Avenue in Philadelphia and the Citizens Bank branch located at 2001 Market Street, and 2942 North 22nd Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, stealing a total of approximately \$11,204.

If convicted, BRABHAM faces a maximum possible sentence on each bank robbery of 20 years imprisonment, 3 years of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Philadelphia Police Department, and has been assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Jose R. Arteaga.
