PRESS RELEASE

PHILADELPHIA – United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of a three-count indictment against Mark Miller, a/k/a "Sharkey," charging him with possession with intent to distribute cocaine base or crack cocaine and cocaine.¹ The indictment specifically charges that: on or about September 22, 2005, Miller possessed with intent to distribute approximately 501 grams of cocaine, and, on or about June 28, 2007, Miller possessed with intent to distribute approximately 81 grams of crack cocaine and 126 grams of cocaine.

If convicted, Miller face a maximum sentence of life imprisonment, a mandatory minimum sentence of 10 years imprisonment, at least 10 years supervised release, and a multi-million dollar fine. This case was investigated by the United States Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA") and is part of an joint city and federal effort to identify and prosecute drug dealers operating in the Frankford section of Philadelphia. The case is assigned to Assistant United States Attorney K.T. Newton.
