PRESS RELEASE

PHILADELPHIA – United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of an Indictment¹ against Primitivo Leyva-Rincon, an alien and citizen of Mexico, who was previously deported from the United States on four prior occasions and who was found present in the United States on June 4, 2007. Leyva-Rincon has been charged in the indictment with illegally reentering the United States after being deported.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 20 years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, three years supervised release, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement and has been assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Anita Eve.
