PHILADELPHIA MAN CHARGED IN INTERNET PIRACY CASE

PHILADELPHIA - United States Attorney Pat Meehan today announced the filing of a two-count Information¹ charging An Duc Do with conspiracy and criminal infringement of a copyright arising from Duc Do's use of a Peer-to Peer computer software file sharing network known as "BitTorrent" to illegally download copyrighted intellectual property. The property included, among other materials, "Flight of the Phoenix," "Harry Potter and the Prison of Azkaban" and "King Arthur."

When he is sentenced, An Duc Do faces a maximum of 10 years imprisonment, a fine of \$500,000, a 3 year period of supervised release and a special assessment of \$200.

This case was investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the United States Department of Justice's Computer Crimes Section and is assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Floyd J. Miller.
