**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about May 16, 2007, in Linwood, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**GREGORY A. SEXTON**

knowingly and forcibly broke into the Linwood Post Office, located at 1401 Huddell Avenue, in Marcus Hook, Pennsylvania, with intent to commit larceny, that is, to steal money and postage stamps, which were the property of the United States Postal Service.
