United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of an indictment¹ against Gregory A. Sexton charging him with burglary of the Linwood Post Office, on May 16, 2007.

If convicted, Sexton faces a maximum sentence of 5 years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, 3 years supervised release, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the United States Postal Inspection Service and has been assigned to Assistant United States Attorney Virgil B. Walker.
