NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of a two-count indictment¹ charging HERIBERTO TORRES, a/k/a “Case,” with distribution of cocaine base (“crack”), and aiding and abetting, in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1).

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of 80 years imprisonment, a mandatory minimum sentence of 5 years in prison, a mandatory minimum of 4 years up to a lifetime of supervised release, and a \$4 million fine.
