INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about May 18, 2006, in Havertown, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**JEROME BENNETT, III**

knowingly received visual depictions which contained materials that had been shipped in  
interstate and foreign commerce, which visual depictions showed minors engaged in sexually  
explicit conduct and the producing of those visual depictions involved the use of minors engaged  
in sexually explicit conduct.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(2).

**COUNT TWO**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

On or about May 18, 2006, in Havertown, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**JEROME BENNETT, III**

knowingly possessed books, magazines, periodicals, films, video tapes and other matter, namely two laptop computers, three external hard drives, and one compact flash card, which contained visual depictions that had been shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, and were produced using materials that had been mailed, shipped, and transported in interstate and foreign commerce. The production of these visual depictions involved the use of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct and the visual depictions were of minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

As a result of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252(a)(2) and 2252(a)(4)(B), set forth in this indictment, defendant

**JEROME BENNETT, III**

shall forfeit to the United States all visual depictions described in Title 18, United States Code Section 2252, and all property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or promote the commission of such offenses, including but not limited to the following items that were seized from defendant BENNETT on May 18, 2006:

- a. one Dell Latitude D510 laptop, serial number CPPDW81;
- b. one Dell Latitude laptop, serial number FZBGV11;
- c. one Netdisk external hard drive, serial number N4093100023;
- d. One Western Digital external hard drive, serial number WCAET1029552;
- e. one Scan Disk 256mb SD Card; and
- f. one Viking Components 16-mb compact flash card.

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2253(a)(1) and (a)(3).
