**COUPLE INDICTED FOR ENTERING FEDERAL BUILDING WITH  
WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION**

PHILADELPHIA - Acting United States Attorney Laurie Magid today announced the filing of a one-count indictment<sup>1</sup> charging Louis C. Boumpani and his wife Kathy Boumpani with one count of possession of a dangerous weapon in a Federal court facility. The indictment alleges that on or about July 31, 2008, Louis Boumpani and Kathy Boumpani possessed three knives and various rounds of ammunition in the William F. Green Federal Building, a Federal court facility in Philadelphia.

If convicted, the defendants face a maximum sentence of two years incarceration, one year supervised release and a fine of \$250,000.

This indictment arose out of an investigation conducted by U.S. Federal Protective Service, the National Park Service, Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, Philadelphia Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. It is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney James R. Pavlock.
