**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about May 5, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**RAYMOND CRUZ-RUIZ,  
a/k/a "Raymond Ruiz-Cruz,"  
a/k/a "Raymond Crurvic,"  
a/k/a "Victor Pedraza,"  
a/k/a "Raymond Ruiz,"**

an alien and native and citizen of Mexico, who had previously been deported and removed from the United States on or about August 21, 1997, and on or about June 15, 1998, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully re-entered and attempted to re-enter the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission.

In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), (b)(1).
