**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about June 10, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

**SORRELL GROVES,**

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a Bersa S.A. Model MOD85 380 caliber semi-automatic, with an obliterated serial number, that was loaded with 14 live rounds of ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

**SORRELL GROVES**


shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of this offense, including, but not limited to:

- (a) a Bersa S.A. Model MOD85 380 caliber semi-automatic with an obliterated serial number, and
- (b) the 14 live rounds of ammunition removed from the firearm described in Paragraph (a) above.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
