INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 6, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

CHRISTOPHER HOLDER

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of Saint Edmond's Federal Savings Bank, 5873 Ridge Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1,344, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of Saint Edmond's Federal Savings Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 9, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,
defendant

CHRISTOPHER HOLDER

knowingly and unlawfully, by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of
M&T Bank, 5873 Ridge Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United
States, that is, approximately \$1,150, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management
and possession of M&T Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit
Insurance Corporation

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT THREE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 11, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of
Pennsylvania, defendant

CHRISTOPHER HOLDER

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of Wachovia Bank, 8527 Germantown Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$1,364, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of Wachovia Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT FOUR

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about June 13, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of
Pennsylvania, defendant

CHRISTOPHER HOLDER

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of
Citizens Bank, 2014 Cottman Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, lawful currency of the United
States, that is, approximately \$1,419, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management
and possession of Citizens Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit
Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
