NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of a one-count indictment¹ charging **JULIO CESAR ALMANZA, a/k/a/ Julio Cesar Almanza Orozco**, a Mexican national, with unlawful re-entry into the United States after deportation, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326. The indictment alleges that on or about December 10, 2007, ALMANZA was found in Leesport, Pennsylvania after having been previously twice deported from the United States in 2004 and 2005.

This indictment arose out of an investigation conducted by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). Defendant ALMANZA faces a maximum sentence of 10 years imprisonment, one year supervised release, a \$250,000 fine and a \$100 special assessment.
