**COUNT ONE**

**THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about October 11, 2007, in Collingdale, in the Eastern District of  
Pennsylvania, defendant

**PAUL J. GRANT**

knowingly possessed one or more films, video tapes, and other matter, including computer storage files and devices, which contain visual depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct, as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(2), and the production of those visual depictions involved the use of minors engaging in such conduct, and which items had been shipped and transported in interstate commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252(a)(4)(B).
