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NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Patrick L. Meehan today announced the filing of an Indictment¹ against Sanusi Bah charging him with (i) possessing a fraudulent immigration document, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1546(a); (ii) possessing a fraudulent identification document, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1028(a)(4); and (iii) possessing a unlawfully produced identification document, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1028(a)(6).

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 16 years imprisonment, a three-year period of supervised release, a \$600,000 fine, and a \$300 special assessment.

The case was investigated by Immigration and Customs Enforcement and has been assigned for prosecution to Assistant United States Attorney Manisha M. Sheth.
