INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about November 21, 2007, in Chester, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

VINCENT LAMAR FRANKLIN

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce a firearm, that is, a .32 caliber Cobra semi-automatic pistol, model: FS32, with an obliterated serial number (later restored using chemical etching methods and found to be: FS019*4*), loaded with one round in the chamber and five rounds of ammunition in the magazine.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).
