Acting United States Attorney Laurie Magid today announced the filing of an information¹ charging two defendants with bank fraud which involved the fraudulent obtaining of unsecured lines of credit totaling approximately \$120,000 from Citizens Bank and the fraudulent cashing of checks drawn on the unsecured lines of credit with Citizens Bank in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.

If convicted of all charges, each of the defendants faces of maximum sentence of 30 years imprisonment and restitution.
