PHILADELPHIA – Acting United States Attorney Lauria Magid today announced the filing of an indictment¹ charging Christopher Smith, a/k/a Lester Livingston, a/k/a Erson McIntosh, a/ka Christopher Boyer, with one count of unlawful re-entering the United States after deportation, in violation of 8 U.S.C. §1326. Specifically, the defendant re-entered the United States after being deported to Jamaica on May 5, 2001.

The defendant was arrested on September 30, 2008 and remains in custody. If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 20 years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, three years of supervised release, and a \$100 special assessment.

This case was investigated by Immigration and Customs Enforcement. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Vineet Gauri.
