

COUNT TWO

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

On or about September 5, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

EDWARD VECCHIONE

knowingly and unlawfully by force and violence, and by intimidation, took from employees of the Port Richmond Savings Bank, located at 2522 East Allegheny Avenue in Philadelphia, lawful currency of the United States, that is, approximately \$3,726, belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Port Richmond Savings Bank, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).
