PHILADELPHIA – United States Attorney Laurie Magid today announced the filing of an indictment¹ charging Larue Hall with being a felon in possession of a firearm, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(1). This offense arises from the defendant's illegal possession of a firearm in Philadelphia on June 24, 2008.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 10 years imprisonment, a maximum fine of \$250,000, three years of supervised release, and a \$100 special assessment.

The case was investigated by the Philadelphia Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives and is being prosecuted by AUSA Joel D. Goldstein.
