**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

At all times material to this indictment:

1. Defendant REGINALD JOHNSON was a United States Postal Service employee at the Philadelphia Processing and Distribution Center in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
2. Defendant REGINALD JOHNSON served as a mail processing clerk. Among his duties was unloading incoming mail from tractor trailers docked at the Distribution Center's loading area.
3. From April 2008 to August 2008, defendant REGINALD JOHNSON stole a total of 2,200 video game DVDs contained in envelopes addressed to Philadelphia-area residents. These envelopes were entrusted to Johnson and came into his possession intended to be conveyed by mail.
4. On or about September 5, 2008, at Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

stole from the mail 50 DVDs contained in envelopes addressed to Philadelphia-area residents,

which were entrusted to him and came into his possession intended to be conveyed by mail.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1709.
