NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Laurie Magid today announced the filing of a one-count indictment¹ charging Reginald Walter Johnson with theft of mail by a postal employee. The indictment alleges that on September 5, 2008, the defendant, while working as a mail handler at the U.S. Postal Service's Processing and Distribution Center in Philadelphia, stole from the mail 50 DVD games that were addressed to Philadelphia area residents.

If convicted, Johnson faces a maximum possible sentence of 5 years imprisonment, a 3-year period of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100.00 special assessment

The case was investigated by the United States Postal Service Office of Inspector General and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Richard Kornylak
