NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Laurie Magid announced the filing of an indictment¹ against JESUS TOVAR-VARGAS, a/k/a “Jesus Lara Gonzalez,” charging him with one count of reentry after deportation. The indictment alleges that on or about March 16, 2009, TOVAR-VARGAS was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on March 17, 2007.

If convicted, TOVAR-VARGAS faces a maximum 10 year term of imprisonment, 3 years supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.
