**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about April 11, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of  
Pennsylvania, defendant

**WILLIAM COLON,**

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate commerce a firearm, that is, a Jennings Bryco, .25 caliber handgun, serial number 1534086, loaded with three rounds of ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

**THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:**

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

**WILLIAM COLON**

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of this offense, including, but not limited to:


- (1) a Jennings Bryco, .25 caliber handgun, serial number 1534086; and
- (2) three rounds of ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
