**INDICTMENT**

**COUNT ONE**

**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:**

On or about June 5, 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania,  
defendant

**NATALYA GORETSKA,**

in a matter within the jurisdiction of the United States Department of Homeland Security, an agency of the executive branch of the United States, knowingly and willfully made materially false, fictitious, and fraudulent statements and representations, and knowingly and willfully falsified, concealed, and covered up trick, scheme, or device, a material fact in that defendant GORETSKA stated on an I-485, Application to Register as Permanent Resident or Adjust Status, Question 3.a. of which asked, "Have you ever within the past ten years been a prostitute or procured anyone for prostitution, or intend to engage in such activities in the future?" and in response, defendant stated, "No," when in fact she had procured persons for prostitution between approximately mid-2002 and early-2004.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1001.
