NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Michael L. Levy announced the filing of an indictment¹ against Pablo Diaz-Rosario, a/k/a Hansel Peguero, a/k/a Hansel Acevedo, charging him with one count of possession with intent to distribute 100 grams or more of heroin and one count of possession with intent to distribute 100 grams or more of heroin within 1000 feet of a school. The defendant was arrested July 2, 2009 following an investigation by the Drug Enforcement Administration.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum potential sentence of 80 years in prison, a mandatory minimum sentence of five years in prison, a possible fine of up to a \$4 million, and a \$100 special assessment. Forfeiture of all proceeds from the offense, all property involved in, and all facilitating property, may also be ordered.

The case was investigated by the Drug Enforcement Administration and the Philadelphia Police Department and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney David J. Caputo.
