INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about October 22, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

DWAYNE PARKER,

having been convicted in a court of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce a firearm, that is, a Beretta .32 caliber semi-automatic pistol, serial number 94214, loaded with 6 live rounds of ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(e).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), set forth in this indictment, defendant

DWAYNE PARKER

shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of this offense, including, but not limited to:

- (a) the Beretta .32 caliber semi-automatic pistol, serial # 94214; and
- (b) the 6 live rounds of ammunition removed from the firearm described in Paragraph (a) above.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
