I N F O R M A T I O N

COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

At all times material to this information:

1. Boys & Girls Club of Philadelphia constituted an “organization” which received annual benefits in excess of \$10,000 in the calendar years 2008 and 2009 under a federal program involving a grant, contract, subsidy, loan, guarantee, and other form of federal assistance, in connection with the provision of daycare, after-school programs, and other services for children of low income families.

2. Between approximately February 2008 and January 2009, Defendant AALIYAH LYLES-MACON was an employee of Boys & Girls Club of Philadelphia and as such was its agent.

3. Between approximately June 2008 and December 2008, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

AALIYAH LYLES-MACON,

being an agent and employee of Boys & Girls Club of Philadelphia, an organization which

received benefits of over \$10,000 in any one-year period under a federal program involving a grant, contract, subsidy, loan, guarantee, insurance or other form of federal assistance, embezzled, stole and obtained by fraud property valued at \$5,000 or more, that is, cash totaling approximately \$53,327, which cash was owned by and under the care, custody and control of Boys & Girls Club of Philadelphia.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 666(a)(1)(A).
