NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Michael L. Levy announced the filing of an indictment¹ against Rigoberto Ramirez-Loeza, a/k/a “Rigoberto Ramirez-Loeza,” a/k/a “Rigoberto Loeza,” a/k/a “Ricardo M. Flores Perez,” charging him with one count of illegal reentry after deportation. The indictment alleges that on or about November 20, 2009, Ramirez-Loeza, was found in the United States after having been deported from the United States on or about May 23, 2006, and June 22, 2007.

If convicted, the defendant faces a maximum sentence of 20 years imprisonment, a three-year term of supervised release, a \$250,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment.
