COUNT ONE

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

From on or about December 20, 2008 through on or about June 13, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOSEPH WARREN

embezzled, stole and knowingly converted to his own use, a thing of value of the United States in excess of \$1000, that is, postage stamps from the United States Postal Service and cash received from customers for postage stamp purchases.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 641.

COUNT TWO

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

From on or about February 10, 2009 to on or about February 13, 2009, in Philadelphia, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, and elsewhere, defendant

JOSEPH WARREN

knowingly and with the intent to defraud used, and attempted to use, and willfully caused the use of, an unauthorized access device, that is, a Citibank credit card, account no. -----5430, in the name of R.P., to obtain things of value aggregating \$1,000 or more during a one-year period, for a total of approximately \$1695.82, thereby affecting interstate and foreign commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1029(a)(2) and (b)(1).
