NEWS RELEASE

JOSEPH WARREN was charged today by Information¹ on charges of theft of government property and unauthorized use of a credit card, announced United States Attorney announced Michael L. Levy. The theft offense arose from WARREN's job as a sales associate at a United States Post Office in Philadelphia where he stole a significant number of postage stamps. The second charge arose out of WARREN's unauthorized, fraudulent purchases with the credit card of another person.

If convicted, defendant WARREN faces a maximum possible sentence of 20 years imprisonment, 3 years of supervised release, a \$500,000 fine, a \$200 special assessment, and restitution.

This case was investigated by the United States Postal Service, Office of the Inspector General and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Denise S. Wolf.
