NEWS RELEASE

Acting United States Attorney Laurie Magid today announced the filing of a Superseding Information¹ against Terrence Amaker, charging Amaker with one count of attempting to pass counterfeit United States currency, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 472. The information alleges that on or about May 21, 2008, defendant Amaker, with intent to defraud, possessed and attempted to pass approximately \$2,760 in counterfeit \$20 Federal Reserve Notes.

If convicted the defendant faces a maximum possible sentence of 20 years imprisonment, a \$250,000 fine, and three years supervised release.

The case was investigated by the United States Secret Service and is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Mark B. Dubnoff.
