NEWS RELEASE

United States Attorney Laurie Magid today announced the filing of a two-count indictment¹ charging Brandon Byrd with the assault and robbery of a United States Postal Service letter carrier in Norristown.

If convicted, Byrd faces a maximum sentence of 40 years imprisonment, three years supervised release, a \$500,000 fine and a \$200 special assessment.
